West on a true line bet. secs. 12 and 13.

Over gently rolling prairie.

- 20.02 Set an iron post, for 1/16 sec. cor. No. 1, bet. secs. 12 and 13, (E. $\frac{1}{2}$) with brass cap stamped

1/16 S 12 in N. half
No 1 S 13 in S. half

Dig pits 18x16x12 ins. E. and W. of cor. 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

West of and alongside the stone, set an iron post, for witness cor. to the C.C., with brass cap stamped

C C in E. edge
T 21 N S 12 in NE. quadrant
R 23 E S 13 in SE. quadrant
P L I R in middle
and W C in addition

This cor. is 10.12 chs. S. 20° 34' E. of the 133 $\frac{1}{2}$ M.P.

From this cor., the old C.C. of secs. 12 and 13, which refers to surveys outside of the reservation, brs.

N. 20° 34' W., 1.06 chs. dist.
