Over rolling land.

18.50 Road, brs. NW. and SE.

22.65 Set an iron post 26 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor. bet. secs. 19 and 30, with brass cap stamped

1/4 S 19 in N. half  
S 30 in S. half

Build a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, N. of cor.

36.00 The M.C. bet. secs. 19 and 30, on bank of Pyramid Lake.

Land, broken, - grazing.  
Soil, sandy, 2nd rate.

Meanders of Pyramid Lake.

Since I established meander corners on 1/16 and center lines on bank of Pyramid Lake, I find it will be necessary to re-meander the entire position of the lake in this township.

July 6, 1911. At 8 a.m., l.m.t., I set off 39° 54' on the lat. arc, 22° 47' N. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, at the M.C. of secs. 3 and 34, on N. bdy. of Tp.

Thence I run with meanders through sec. 3.

S. 15° 32' W. 29.59 " To M.C. on center line.  
S. 18° 59' W. 31.00 " To M.C. bet. secs. 3 and 4.

Land, rolling, - grazing.  
Soil, sandy, 2nd rate.

Thence through sec. 4.

Over rolling land.

S. 21° 34' W. 11.55 chs. To M.C. bet. secs. 4 and 9.

Land, rolling, - grazing.  
Soil, sandy loam 2nd rate.

Thence through sec. 9.

Over rolling land, banks well defined.

S. 24° 45' W. 20.70 chs.
