

## Subdivision of frac. T. 27 N., R. 23 E.

## Chains

East on a true line bet. secs. 15 and 22.

Over mountainous land, descending rough and broken slope.

22.00 Rocky ridge, brs. N. 5° W. and S. 5° E.

35.00 Bottom of rocky and steep slope. Thence gradual descent toward lake.

40.00 Set an iron post for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. bet. secs. 15 and 22, with brass cap stamped

$\frac{1}{4}$  S 15 in N. half  
S 22 1912 in S. half

Build a mound of stone 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor.

50.00 Deep drain, course S. 45° E.

57.30 Spring, brs. S., about 2.50 chs.

About 8.00 chs. South is a fence which is the north bdy. of an enclosed field containing about 40.00 acres. This field has been cultivated and is known as "The Potato Patch".

60.30 Draw, course S. 35° E.

70.50 Road, brs. N. 45° E. and S. 45° W.

74.04 Intersect the E. bdy. of Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation at a point from which the 47 Mile Post brs. N. 31°58'W. 26.57 chs.

Set an iron post for C.C. of secs. 15 and 22, with brass cap stamped

1912 in S.  
3 notches on N. and S. edges

Dig a pit 30x24x12 ins. on line SE. of cor. 7 ft. dist., and a pit 24x18x12 ins. W. of cor. 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Bench Mark brs. N. 36° 35' E., 24.67 chs. dist.

Land, rolling and mountainous, - grazing and agricultural. Soil, sandy and rocky, 2nd and 3rd rate, No timber.
