Chains

69.98 Intersect the E. bdy. of Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation at a point from which the 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ Mile Post brs. S.31°58'E. 2.00 chs. dist.

Set an iron post for C.C. of secs. 22 and 23, with brass cap stamped

P L in NE.
C C P L I R in W.
T 27 N S 22 in SW.
R 23 E S 23 in SE.
1912 in S.

2 notches on E. and W. edges

Dig a pit 30x24x18 ins. on line NW. of cor., 7 ft. dist., and a pit 24x18x12 ins. S. of cor., 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, rolling and mountainous, - grazing and agricultural. Soil, rocky and sandy, 2nd and 3rd rate. No timber.

Meanders of Winnemucca Lake.

June 29, 1912. At 8h 00m A.M., l.m.t., I set off 40° 09 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' on the lat. arc, 23° 15' N. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of frac. secs. 2 and 35, on S. bdy. of Tp., which brs. 26.50 chs. East of the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35.

Thence I run with meanders in sec. 35.

Over level land, along shore of Winnemucca Lake.
