- 31.00 Vacant house, brs. E. 15 lks. dist.
- 35.25 Lateral ditch, brs. N. 45° E. and S. 45° W.
- 35.50 Enter cultivated field, brs. E. and W.
- 40.00 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. bet. secs. 8 and 9. West of and alongside,  
set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 26 ins. in the  
ground, for W.C., with brass cap stamped
- $\frac{1}{4}$  S 8 in W. half  
S 9 in E. half  
and W C in addition, from which
- A cottonwood 10 ins. dia. brs. S. 52° E. 141 lks. dist.

- 41.75 Leave cultivated field; enter scattered brush, brs. E.  
and W.
- 44.75 Wire fence, brs. E. and W.
- 45.05 Left bank of Truckee River, course N. 45° E.

- 48.13 Point for C.C. of secs. 8 and 9, will fall in slough,

- Land, level agricultural, irrigated.  
Soil, sandy loam, 1st rate.
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- From the C.C. of secs. 9 and 16, on reservation bdy.,  
2.76 chs., N. 47° 50' W. of the 2 Mile Post, I run  
S. 89° 45' E. on a true line bet. secs. 9 and 16, the
