

## Subdivision of T. 21 N. R. 24 E.

## Chains

From the C.C. of secs. 23 and 26, I run  
East on a random line bet. secs. 23 and 26.

37.18 Intersect the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. bet. secs. 23 and 26, which is  
a volcanic stone, 10x8x8 ins., above ground, mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on  
N. face, and witnessed by pits and mound.

73.17 Intersect the reservation bdy.

No trace of old C.C.

77.29 Intersect the cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26, which is  
a volcanic stone, 12x12x6 ins., above ground, mkd. 2  
notches on S., 1 on E., and witnessed by a mound of  
stone.

Returning to the C.C. of secs. 23 and 26, thence I run  
East on a true line bet. secs. 23 and 26.

Over rolling land.

37.18 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. bet. secs. 23 and 26, heretofore des-  
cribed.

West of and alongside the stone, set an iron post for  
W.C., with brass cap stamped

$\frac{1}{4}$  S 23 in N. half  
S 26 in S. half  
and W C in addition

73.17 (35.99) Intersect the reservation bdy. 15.54 chs., N. 27°  
29' E. of the 7 Mile Post.

Set an iron post for C.C. of secs. 23 and 26, with brass  
cap stamped

C C in W. edge  
T 21 N S 26 in SW. quadrant  
R 24 E S 23 in NW. quadrant  
P L I R in middle  
2 notches on S. and 4 notches on N. edge

Dig pits 24x18x12 ins. crosswise on each line, NE. and  
SW., 3 ft., and W. of cor. 7 ft. dist., and raise a  
mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

77.29 (40.11) The cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26.

Land, rolling - grazing.  
Soil, sandy loam, 2nd rate.
