62.00 Intersect the original 9th Standard Parallel N., at a point from which the original standard cor. for secs. 35 and 36, T. 46 N., R. 53 E., bears East, 1.35 chs. dist. The cor. is a granite stone, 6 x 8 x 16 ins., properly marked, lying loose in the west pit. I reset stone at its original position as determined by hole which it had formerly occupied. The cor. is witnessed by pits and mound as required. At point of intersection set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for the SW. cor. of T. 46 N., R. 54 E., with brass cap marked  
SC T46N R54E S31 in NE quadrant,  
1911 in S., with 6 notches on N. and E. edges; dig pits, 36 x 36 x 12 ins., on line, N. and E. of post, 8 ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth, 5 ft. base, 2½ ft. high, NE. of cor. 4 ft. dist.
