Over rolling prairie, descending rocky NE. slope.

10.00 Dry drain, course N. 30° W. Ascend.

24.00 Top of ascent, brs. E. and W. Begin gradual descent.

30.00 Same drain, course NE.

39.80 Same drain, course N. 30° W.

40.00 Set an iron post for the 1/4 sec. cor. bet. secs. 9 and 10, stamped in cap
