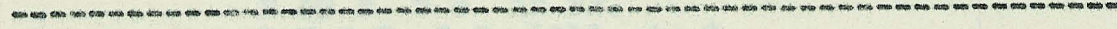


Subdivision of T. 47 N., R. 50 E.

Chains

80.00 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.

Land, rolling prairie. (Grazing land, 80.00 chs.)
Soil, stony, 3rd and 4th rate.
B rush, scattered sage.
No timber.



West on a true line bet. secs. 4 and 9.

Over prairie, through sage brush.

.30 Dry drain, course NW. Begin ascent.

10.00 Top of ascent, brs. N. and S. Thence gradual descent.

38.00 Dry drain, course NW.

40.00 Set an iron post for the 1/4 sec. cor. bet. secs. 4 and 9,
stamped in cap

1/4 S 4 in N. half
S 9 1911 in S. half

Build a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, N. of cor.

40.50 Dry drain, course N. 10° E.

52.00 Dry drain, course NW.

58.73 Intersect the W. bdy. of the Duck Valley Indian Reserva-
tion at a point from which the C.C. of secs. 9 and 16
brs. South, 79.90 chs. dist.

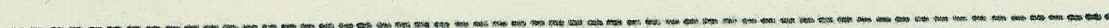
Set an iron post for the C.C. of secs. 4 and 9, stamped
in cap

R 50 E S 9 in SE.
D V I R C C in E.
1911 in S.

5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edge

Build a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, E. of cor.

Land, rolling prairie. (Grazing land, 58.73 chs.)
Soil, 3rd and 4th rate.
Brush, scattered sage.
No timber.



N. 0° 02' W. bet. secs. 3 and 4.

Over heavily rolling prairie.

9.35 Intersect the Idaho-Nevada state boundary line, at a point
from which the 119 mile post brs. N. 88° 54' E., 22.08
