11.00 Leave willows bearing E. and W. Ascend over broken land, through scattered sage and huckleberry.

40.00 Set an iron post for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 15 and 22, stamped in cap

$\frac{1}{4}$ S 15 in N. half
S 22 1911 in S. half

Build a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

44.00 Dry draw, course SW.

57.00 Top of ascent, brs. NE. and SW. Begin descent.

65.00 Dry draw, course SW. Begin ascent.

69.25 Top of ascent, brs. NE. and SW. Begin descent.

74.50 Foot of descent, brs. NE. and SW. Begin ascent.

80.00 The cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23.

Land, mountainous. (Grazing land, 74.80 chs.; brushy land, 5.20 chs.)

Soil, stony, 3rd rate.

Brush, willows along stream branch.

No timber.

East on a true line bet. secs. 14 and 23.

Over mountainous land.

13.00 Dry draw, course S.

20.00 Dry draw, course S.

30.00 Draw, course SW. Begin ascent of NW. slope.

39.04 Intersect the E. bdy. of the Duck Valley Indian Reservation at a point from which the C.C. of secs. 23 and 26, brs. South, 80.06 chs. dist.

Set an iron post for C.C. of secs. 14 and 23, stamped in cap

T 46 N S 23 in SW.

R 53 E S 14 in NW.

D V I R C C in W.

1911 in S.

3 notches on N. and S. edges

Dig pits 24x18x12 ins. N. and S., 3 ft., and W. of post

7 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft.

high, W. of cor.

Land, mountainous. (Grazing land, 39.04 chs.)

Soil, 3rd rate.

No timber.
