

Subdivision of T. 46 N., R. 53 E.

Chains

Soil, stony, 3rd and 4th rate.
Brush, willow, laurel and scattered sage brush and grease-wood.
No timber.

East on a true line bet. secs. 2 and 11.

Over mountainous land, through scattered sage brush, ascending NW. slope.

8.00 Top of ascent, brs. N. and S. Begin descent of SE. slope.

24.00 Dry drain, course S. 20° E.

33.00 Dry drain, course S. 10° E. Foot of descent; begin ascent of broken SW. slope.

39.21 Intersect the E. bdy. of the Duck Valley Indian Reservation at a point from which the C.C. of secs. 11 and 14, brs. South, 80.06 chs. dist.

Set an iron post for the C.C. of secs. 2 and 11, stamped in cap

T 46 N S 11 in SW. quadrant
R 53 E S 2 in NW. quadrant
D V I R C C in W,
1911 in S.
5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edge

Build a mound of stone 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, mountainous. (Grazing land, 39.21 chs.)
Soil, stony, 4th rate.
No timber.

Sept. 5, 1911. At the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11, I set off 7° 02' N. on the decl. arc, and at 11h 59m a.m., l.m.t., observe the sun on the meridian; the resulting lat. is 41° 55'.

Thence from the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11, I run N. 0° 03' E. on a random line bet. secs. 2 and 3.

40.00 Set temp. 1/4 sec. cor.

79.84 Falls 19 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, on N. bdy. of Tp., previously described.
