- 25.00 Bottom of draw, course W.
 27.90 Wood road, brs. N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.
 33.50 Drain, course SW.; skirted with brush. Begin ascent.
 39.98 True point for the center $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
 52.00 Summit of ridge, brs. NE. and SW. Begin descent.
 66.00 Drain, course S. 80° W. Enter aspen, brs. E. and W.
 Leave prairie; begin ascent.
 80.03 (40.05) The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 27 and 34.
 Land, mountainous. (Grazing land, 74.40 chs.; brush, 5.60
 chs.)
 Soil, stony, 3rd rate.

 53 E. brs. South, 79.94 chs. dist.
 Set an iron post for C.C. of secs. 26 and 36, stamped in
 cap
 T 47 N S 35 in SW.

 1911 in S.
 1 notch on S. and 5 notches on N. edge
 Dig pits 24x18x12 ins. N. and S., 3 ft., and W. of post
