4 notches on S. and 2 notches on N. edge,

An aspen 12 ins. dia. brs. N.54°39'W., 1.06 chs. dist.

A quaking aspen 12 ins. dia. brs. S.36°06'W., 71 lks. dist.

Land, mountainous. (Bruahy land, 39.34 chs.)

Brush, aspen, laurel and sage.

Aug. 18, 1911. At 8 a.m., l.m.t., I set off 41° 59' on  
the lat. arc, 13° 21' N. on the decl. arc, and deter-  
mine a meridian with the solar, at the cor. of secs. 10,  
11, 14 and 15.

Along W. slope, through dense aspen and laurel undergrowth
