

Subdivision of T. 47 N., R. 53 E.

Chains

68.00 West edge of valley, course S. Enter prairie, brs. N. and S.

72.00 East edge of valley, course S. Enter aspen and laurel thicket, brs. N. and S. Leave prairie.

80.10 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.

Land, mountainous. (Grazing land, 29.75 chs.; brushy land, 50.25 chs.)

Soil, 3rd rate.

Brush, aspen, laurel and sage.

Timber, stunted aspen, 8.00 chs.

Aug. 18, 1911.

Aug. 19, 1911. at 8 a.m., l.m.t., I set off 42° 00' on the lat. arc, 13° 02' N. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, at the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.

Thence I run

East on a true line bet, secs. 2 and 11.

Through aspen and laurel undergrowth, ascending.

19.80 Cliff, 30 ft. high, brs. N. and S.

27.19 Triangulation monument brs. S. 32° 39' E. ^{about 2 chs. dist.} Ridge, brs. N. and S. Top of ascent; begin descent.

39.53 Intersect the E. bdy. of the Duck Valley Indian Reservation at a point from which the C.C. of secs. 11 and 14 brs. South 80.01 chs. dist.

Set an iron post for C.C. of secs. 2 and 11, stamped in cap

T 47 N S 11 in SW. quadrant
R 53 E S 2 in NW. quadrant
D V I R C C in W.
1911 in S.
5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edge

Dig pits 24x18x12 ins. N. and S., 3 ft., and W. of post 7 ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, mountainous. (Brushy, 39.53 chs.)
Soil, stony and gravelly, 3rd and 4th rate.
Brush, aspen and laurel.
No timber.
