Since the Reservation has been enlarged by Executive order, this point is not on present bdy. line. I set temp. stake at this point since a portion of the Res'n bdy. must be projected from this point.

59.22 set an iron post for 1/16 sec. cor. No. 12 bet. secs. 31 and 36, S $\frac{1}{2}$, with brass cap stamped

1/16 S 36 in W.
S 31 " E.
No 12 1912 in S.

Dig pits 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. of post 3 ft. dist.; and raise mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

59.95 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S. 45° E.

Leave cultivated field.

61.80 Wire fence brs. N. 20° E. and S. 20° W.

67.10 Wagon road brs. N. 70° W. and S. 70° E.

70.65 Wagon road brs. N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.

77.10 Wire fence brs. N. 45° E. and S. 45° W.

78.96 The cor. of Tps. 14 and 15 S., Rgs. 65 and 66 E., herein-
before described.

Soil, gravelly, 3rd rate; and sandy loam, 1st rate.

South on a random line bet. secs. 1 and 6.

20.00 Set temp. 1/16 sec. cor. No. 6.

41.52 Fall $14\frac{1}{2}$ lks. W. of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 1 and 6, which is a granite stone 12x8x8 ins. above ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and witnessed by mound of earth and stone to the W.

Returning to the cor. of Tps. 14 and 15 S., Rgs. 65 and 66 E.,

Thence I run

S. 0° 12' E. on a true line bet. secs. 1 and 6,

Over level bottom land.

3.50 Enter brush of sunflower and arrow weed, brs. E. and W.

12.00 Left bank of Moapa River, 25 lks. wide, course S. 45° E.
