Chains

63.68 The C. C. of secs. 1 and 6, T. 15 S., Rgs. 65 and 66 E.  
A portion of the above line is the present boundary of  
the Reservation, which portion will be determined when  
the 1/16 lines are run in sec. 1.  
Land, broken and mountainous. 6.55 chs. cultivated.  
Soil, stony, 3rd rate; and sandy loam, 1st rate.

Thence I run  
S. 44° 15' E. on a true line along Reservation bdy.,  
Over broken land.

4.50 Draw, drains NE.

5.50 Set 3-inch iron post for Sta. 6, with brass cap stamped  
Sta 6 M I R

Raise mound of stone 6 ft. base, 4 ft. high, N. of post.

Land, broken, mountainous.  
Soil, stony, 3rd rate.

From ridge about 12 chs. Northerly of Sta. 6 (Sta. 6 and  
the C.C. of secs. 6 and 31 are both visible), after re-  
peated trial, I determine a point on line, and determine  
bearing of line N. 14° 30' E.

Returning to Sta. 6,

Thence I run

N. 14° 30' E. on a true line along the Reservation bdy.,  
Over broken, mountainous land.

0.85 Draw, drains E.

2.70 Ridge, brs. E. and W.

8.60 Draw, drains E.

12.25 Ridge, brs. N. 70° W. and S. 70° E.

Begin descent to river bottom.

17.70 Wire fence, brs. N. 45° W. and S. 45° E.

18.50 Enter level bottom, brs. W. and S. 60° E.

22.80 Irrigation ditch, 10 lks. wide, course E.

24.50 Moapa River, 30 lks. wide, course S. 65° E.

52.00 Drain, course E.
