

Descriptions.

This Township is considerably broken and mountainous, containing some extensive & valuable tracts of timber, and the Smoke River is a continued rapids through the whole extent of its passage through the Township affording any amount of water power.

On the N. W. part of Sec. 6, some Coal has been found of very good quality, but no regularly defined coal mine. The soil produces the finest natural pasturage in the country. The formation is Sand Stone along the N. boundary & granite on the S. E. & W. boundaries, and on the river, Ferruginous boulders.
