

Field Notes of the Survey of the  
Humboldt River Guide Meridians,  
located in the State of Nevada, by  
William Epler, Deputy Surveyor, under  
his Contract No. 1 bearing date 12<sup>th</sup> day  
of June 1867.

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As per Special instructions, bearing  
date June 12<sup>th</sup> 1867, I locate at the  
corner to Townships 21 North, Ranges  
35 & 36 East, of the Mount Diablo  
Base and Meridian, on the fourth  
Standard Parallel, a Stone Monument  
as follows. A calcined or Volcanic  
rock of an ashy color, 50 inches long  
15 inches wide and 8 inches thick  
in a mound of stone, four feet in  
diameter and three feet in height  
with the letters H. R. G. M. cut  
plainly on the north and south  
sides of the Stone Monument,
