T. 25 N. between Ranges 35 and 36

- Chained North, between Sections 1 and 6
 $\vee. 17^{\circ} 15'$ East
- 6.00 To the Summit of a ridge, bears N. W.
- 13.00 A Prairie, runs N. W.
- 25.00 To the Summit of a low smooth ridge
 which bears N. W. and foot of
 Mountain Range which bears N. 60°
 E. for about seven miles, thence northerly,
 and S. 60° W. From Summit of ridge
 begin smooth descent towards the
 plain -
- 40.00 Set a trap rock, 25 x 8 x 6 for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor.
 as per instructions -
- 80.00 Set a dark colored volcanic rock,
 32 x 20 x 6, for Standard Corner to
 Townships 25 and 26 North, Ranges
 35 and 36 East, with mound of
 stone as per instructions -

Sand first 25.00 chs. broken -
 remainder sloping easily towards
 the North west. Vegetation a sparse
 growth of Greasewood -
