

Humboldt River Guide Meridian

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General Description.

Land mostly level greasewood plain. Generally strongly alkaline and worthless. Much of it would be productive and valuable if irrigation could be effected, which is impracticable, except, possibly, by artesian wells.

To the west of here was observed many clumps of Buffalo bushes. Indicating good soil and water near the surface. Some grass land was also seen two or three miles to the west.

The name of this valley is Buena Vista Valley.
