General Description -
 Surface broken by low mountains
 and mostly covered by drifting sand
 formation principally slate, trap
 and granite. Vegetation Sage
 and Greasewood - no surface
 water -

I terminate the survey of the Humboldt
 River Guide Meridian at the corner
 to Townships 38 and 39 North, Ranges
 35 and 36 East, deeming it unsafe
 to extend it farther, because, of hostile
 Indians that infest the country,
 on and in the vicinity of Quinn's River.
 I do this in compliance with Special
 instructions, bearing date June 12th
 1867 -
