

Humboldt River Guide Meridian  
36 E. Mount Diablo Meridian -

General Description -

Surface broken by low mountains and mostly covered by drifting sand formation principally slate, basalt and granite. Vegetation sage and greasewood - no surface water -

I terminate the survey of the Humboldt River Guide Meridian at the corner to Townships 38 and 39 North, Range 35 and 36 East, deeming it unsafe to extend it farther because of hostile Indians that infest the country on and in the vicinity of Grinn's River. I do this in compliance with special instructions bearing date June 11<sup>th</sup> 1867 -
