

Reese River Guide Meridian

Between Ranges 42, & 43. East T^p. 17. North.

South.	On East Boundary of Sec. 25, Contund,
x 64.50	Ascend,
67.50	Top of bench, and ascend, along west side of hill, the foot of the Toyabe Range,
80.00	Set chain and stake for corner to Secs. 25, 30, 36, 31, in mound of earth, with pits for instructs, Land, same as last mile,

July 20th.

It being impossible to chain at this point over some very rough and precipitous ridges that project westerly into the valley, called "The Pinn of Rocks," I established a signal South on line on the summit of the mountain, and from the corner to Secs. 25, 30, 36, 31. I ran the 25 into the valley, 60 chs, from which point the signal on summit bore S. 20. E. the distance resulting being 164.50 ^{chs. 9 1/2}. From signal I ran North 4.80 and erected a mound of rock, with a
