

Second Standard Parallel North,
South Boundary T. 11. N. R. 41. E.

West. Cor South Boundary Of Sec. 31.

Var. $15\frac{1}{2}$ E.

Descending rocky hill, sloping N.

4000 Set chained $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. in mound of rock.

52.00 Ascend, enter scattering Mackinaw

65.00 Descend over steep rocks.

80.00 Set chained Post for Cor. to Secs. 31. & 36.

T. 11. N. R. 40. & 41. E. in mound of rock.

3rd. Late rocky mountainous land.

The head of Reese River Valley bears N. E. about 6 miles.

This line runs the whole distance over the rough peaks, and ridges that separate the water, running into Smoky Valley, Prairie Co. Twin rivers, and Reese River. There was no opportunity for offsetting on Township or Section lines. It was impossible to use the chain and the only resort was to careful triangulation, not being able at times to make a mile a day from the difficulty of climbing from one steep ridge to another.
