"Note" The closure on the First-Standard North with the State line as run by Messrs Chase & Lash under their Contract bearing date July 18th 1867, was closed to far East by 20.93 chs, Monuments having been found at that point and supposed to be the Official Monuments as Established by the Official Survey, but are found to be Monuments established by parties in ~~finding~~ running the line to see if Aurora was in California, Mr Chase & Lash therefore under their present

Contract moved the Cor on the first Standard to read as follows. S 6 N, R 26 E from the 1/4 Sec Cor on South boundary of Sec 35

- 44.90 Dead Cedar
- 50.00 Summit of detached Ridge S 75° E
- 65.67 to Cor previously Established as on the State Line
- 80.00 Cor to Secs 34 & 35 Trap Stone 12 x 10 x 8 in mound of Stone Cor on gentle S.W. Slope.

- 3.00 From Cor to Secs 34 & 35 ran West Var 16° 15' E Ravine bears S.E.
- 6.60 intersect the Boundary between Nevada

And California set post in Mound of Stone as per instructions for Closing cor on State Boundary Cor on gentle S.E. Slope, Road from Big Meadows to Aurora bears South distance 1/2 Mile
