South Boundary T. 26 N. R. 35 E

Beginning February 15th 1868. at
 the established Standard corner, between
 T 25th & 26 N Ranges 35th & 36 E
 of the Mt. Diablo base Meridian, find
 corner monument standing and agrees
 with the description furnished me by
 the Office. viz: a dark colored volcanic
 rock 32 + 20 + 6, for Standard corner, with
 mound of stone as per instructions
 from Standard corner

Star Peak bears	N. 70° 30' W
Indian Peak bears	N. 36 1/4° W
Granite Peak bears	N. 31 3/4° E

By back ^{3rd} foresights on the Humboldt
 river guide meridian I ascertain the va-
 riation to be 17° 35' E from the above described Cor^{er}
 West on the South boundary of Section 36 Va
 17° 35' E
 6.00 Ravine, runs North
