From the corner to 1, 6, 7, 12, to avoid a bend of the Humboldt, I offset East 3 chs. thence North 19.50, thence West 3 chs. to true line, thence North

1.25 To left bank of Humboldt River

2.36 To right bank 111 chs wide, corner N. by N.

20.50 Set ch and 1/4 Sec. post in mound of earth with pits for instructions in good grass land.

30.64 Leave grass land, enter Sage.

60.50 Set ch and post in mound of earth with pits for instructions for Cor. to Secs. 1, 6, 31, 36, Tps. 34, and 35. N.

1st rate level land, mostly grass land.

North Bet. Secs. 31, and 36. T. 35. N.

va. 17 1/2 E.

4.75 Cross old emigrant road, corner N. E.

46.00 Set ch and 1/4 Sec. post in mound of earth with pits for instructions.

70.00 Ascend.

80.00 Set ch and post for Cor. to Secs. 25, 30, 36, 31, in mound of earth with pits for instructions.

1st 1/2 level 1st rate, remainder 2d, rate. Grass & Sage
