

This line commences on the Fourth Standard, and runs North through Gilsens Valley, through some good pasturage land, thence over a low divide separating the waters flowing South, from those running North into the Humboldt in follow along the narrow valley of Huntington Cr., one of the head branches of the South Fork of the Humboldt, to its junction with Smiths Cr., another branch of the South Fork, thence through the valley of the South Fork, crossing that stream, and over a short range of mountains bearing N. E. and S. W. on the South Bank of the Humboldt, and crossing that stream terminates on the 7th Standard North on the base of a Range of Mts. bearing E. by N. on the North side of the Humboldt.

The Guide Meridian does not run through a rich country, but after passing the 5th Standard North, upon the Eastern side of the Meridian and between it and the West base of the East Humboldt range, and extending North through the entire valley of the South Fork to the North side of the main valley of the
