This Township is generally level with
a rich alluvial soil, and with irrigation
will be first rate farming land. A
large portion of the Township can
be irrigated both from Old River and
Stillwater Slough. The alluvial land
is principally covered with large grass
bunch especially in the eastern portion.
The sand hills are covered with
good bunch grass.

There are some small lakes in sections
14 and 16 made by the overflowing of Old
river which will dry up during the season
