

## General Description of Lewis River Valley.

Townships 41, 42, 43, 44 North Range 37 East contain a large amount of fine agricultural land. The East boundary of these Townships run along the Base of the Mountains and through the foot-hills.

This portion of the Valley is well watered, having fine Mountain streams every two or three miles. The foot hills are covered with Bunch Grass and White Sage, which furnish a fine range for Stock. This Range of Mountains is of Granite formation as far as I can ascertain. All the streams flowing from it for a distance of two or three miles from the foot-hills, have rock or gravel bottoms, being for the most part Granite, Slate, or Quartz. The most of these streams especially Buffalo and Millen Creek contain Gold!

Township 45 North Range 37 East

This Township is fine arable land, with the exception of a few sections in the North West part, which are in the Mountains.
