

Sixth Standard Parallel, North. 4

Began July 16th 1869, on the "Humboldt River Guide Meridian" at the established corner to Townships 30 and 31 North, Ranges 35 and 36 East. Find corner monument standing, and agrees with description furnished by the office, to wit:

Having ascertained the variation of the needle to be $17^{\circ} 30'$ East, by retracing the Humboldt Guide Meridian, North and South of the Township Corner, I ran thence along the South Boundary of T. 31 N. R. 35 E.

West, on the South Boundary of Sec 36.

Var. $17^{\circ} 30'$ East

- 24.00 Ravine, Course S. W. - Enter "Rueña Vista" Valley bears $N^{42} E$ S.
- 40.00 Set a charred post in mound with pits as per instructions for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor.
- 41.50 Ravine, Course S. W.
- 80.00 Set a charred post in mound with pits, as per
