

Sixth Standard Parallel, North

8

From Corner, "Star Peak" bears  $N 74 \frac{3}{4} W$   
Sonoma Peak bears  $N 35 \frac{1}{2} E$ .

Base of High Mountains 10 chs West, bear Stand E.  
Sand 1<sup>st</sup> half mile level - balance slopes E - 2<sup>nd</sup> rate  
Sage brush - Grease wood - Brunch grass

Note - This Standard was not extended  
farther West, the line passing over very high,  
steep and rocky mountains, rendering it  
impossible to measure the line and establish  
the corners thereon.

July 16<sup>th</sup> 1889

Began July 17<sup>th</sup> 1889 on the Humboldt  
River Guide Meridian at the established  
corner to Townships 30 and 31 North, Ranges  
35 and 36 East, and ran thence along  
the South Boundary of  $T 31 N. R. 36 E$ .  
East, on the South Boundary of  $Sic 31$   
Var.  $17^{\circ} 30' East$ .
