General Description

The Sixth Standard Parallel North running West from the Humboldt-River Guide Meridian along the S. boundary of Township 31 N. Range 35 East passes through "Pueca Vista" Valley from the East to the West side over mostly level land, covered with Sage brush and Grease wood and nearly all arable. From the Humboldt-River Guide Meridian running East it passes over a rough mountainous country (E. Range of the Humboldt Mountains and foot-hills) covered with Sage brush and bunch grass and scattering dwarf Cedar trees, mostly unfit for cultivation until "Grass Valley" is reached near the Cor to T 31 N. R 38<sup>th</sup> and 39<sup>th</sup> E.
