Field Notes of the Survey of the
Exterior boundaries of Township 33 N.
Range 38 E. W. Diablos Base and Meridian

It being impossible to run North or East
from the Cor to Townships 32 and 33 N.
Ranges 38 and 39 East, or to run any part
of the Eastern boundary of this Township, -
the line passing over high, rocky, precipitous
mountains, rendering it impossible to
measure the line and establish the corners
thereon

I began August 5th 1869 at the
established corner to Townships 33 and 34
N. Ranges 37 and 38 E. - and run thence
East, on a true line bet Sec. 6 and 31

Var. $17^{\circ} 30'$ East

Ascend gentle West slope

38.20

Set a charred post in mound with pits as per
instructions for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec Cor. - being the Convergence
that would arise in running the Range line
