 7 and 8 S. Ranges 55-56 E,

gravelly S. slope good bunch grass  
 soil 2' deep - Oct 22 - 1869

This line descends to the Valley over  
 very rough broken hills or ridges -  
 the ridges are sharp and craggy -

The formation is limestone and  
 shows mineral indications

There is some Cedar and Pinon - and  
 scattering bayonet trees - They ~~endogenous~~  
 are endogenous trees with bayonet shaped  
 leaves which are extremely tough  
 and fibrous and will doubtless prove  
 valuable in time for the manufacture of  
 coarse sackings &c - The wood is pithy or  
 spongy and useful for fuel -
