

A description of the Country to the Eastward
of the Ruby Colley Guide Meridian -

The general direction of all the
Mountains is N. and S. Between these ranges are
Valleys which are very productive whenever
water can be obtained. White River is a considerable
stream heading about 6 or 8 miles south of the 3^d
Standard North and running south to about
the 1st Standard North where it sinks - There is
a large amount of first rate grass and grain land
on this stream. Several thousand tons of Hay were
cut this year for the White Pine Market - There
is abundance of water to irrigate a large scope
of Country - This Valley lies East of the White
Pine range of Mountains and about 30 or 40
miles East of the R. B. G. M. There are a large
number of settlers in this Valley - The 2^d Standard
E should be produced the 1st Standard N. Run East
from the Meridian and the Township and
subdivision lines run. Grant. Troy. Seymour
