- 40.00 Set a charred post in mound with pit as per instructions for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor.
- 50.30 A road course N. E. and S. W.
- 80.00 Set a charred post in mound with pit as per instructions for Cor to Secs. 29-30-31 and 32
Saw level - soil 2" rate
Edge burst
Base of Ruby Mountains about 25' W
bear S W and N 20° E.
