Field Notes of the survey of the Exterior
Boundaries of Township 29 N. R. 59 E.
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian

The greater portion of this Township lies in
Franklin Lake, which lies in a N E and S W
direction, is about 4 miles wide and quite deep,
on the E side of the lake is a strip of level
sandy land unfit for Cultivation and about
a mile or a mile and one half wide following
the direction of the lake. The balance of the
Township is mountainous except the N W 1/2 of
Sec. 6 which is 1¹/₂ rate meadow.

The South and East boundaries run over
high, precipitous, rocky mountains, mostly
barren and destitute of Mineral and timber,
and were therefore not run. Nearly the
whole township being unfit for Cultivation, it
should not be subdivided.
