

General Description

The 8th Standard Parallel North. in Range 63 East runs over land, rolling, hilly or mountainous, unfit for Cultivation and destitute of timber or minerals and mostly covered with Sage brush, Grease wood, ^{and} scattering bunch grass. In Ranges 64 and 65 the land is mostly level or slightly rolling, covered with Sage brush, Grease wood and bunch grass and the soil fair, and suitable for raising grain. In range 66 the land is generally slightly rolling, Sage brush land, and the soil mostly too sandy for cultivation and at a short distance on each side of the line the land is hilly and worthless.

If extended East from the Corner to Township 41 N. Ranges 66 and 67 E. the line would pass for 4 or 5 miles over rolling sandy land unfit for Cultivation and thence over high hills and mountains mostly barren.

If extended West from the Corner to Township
