

The Eastern portions of all these 4 Townships - (7, 8, 9, 10 & 12 62E) is mountainous covered with good timber and good grass.

The mountains also show strong indications of mineral - and may be considered Mineral Land.

The mountains of this range furnish excellent grazing - and good covering them in great abundance and springs of water appearing in the ravines.

The slope at the foot of the mountains in the valley - has a soil of gravelly loam and would all be good farming land if irrigated. In townships 7 and 9 are some fine springs and good crops of barley and vegetables growing. White sage and bunchgrass
