General Description

The subdivided portion of this township with the exception of the Southern tier of Sections is mostly rolling and covered with Sage brush, Grease wood, Bunch grass with scattering Juniper timber on the low hills. The soil is good and suitable for raising grains; the extreme Southern portion being quite rich and a considerable part now under cultivation. The level portion in the North Eastern is very good soil, that near the Spanish Springs in Sec. 12 being above average and now under cultivation.
