

General Description

The subdivided portion of this Township is generally slightly rolling and covered with Sage brush - Grease wood. White Sage and Bunch and Rye grass and is mostly good grazing land and a considerable portion suitable for raising a medium crop of grain. There is a fine Spring in the S.E. 1/4 of Sec 3, with a good supply of water and surrounded by a thick growth of willows.

The unsubdivided portion is hilly and mountainous with poor soil, unfit for cultivation, with but little timber and no mines opened.
