Sixth Standard Parallel North, in Range 46 East

General Description

The Sixth Standard Parallel North,
running East from the Co. to Townships
31 North, Ranges 45 and 46 East. Passes
over the gentle N slope of mountain base,
with good soil, suitable for raising grain
or for grazing purposes, until it reaches a
point about 60 chains E. of the corner to Sec.
33 and 34. thence, to the corner to Twp
31 N - R 46 and 47 East - it passes over
hilly and mountainous land with soil
mostly poor and unfit for cultivation.

The whole line runs over land covered with
Sage brush. some scattering bunch grass and
some White Sage.

The line if extended further East will pass
over high rough mountains, with but little
timber and no vines or trees.
