4.60 Along N. slope of hill.  
 20.50 Descend abruptly.  
 30.55 Intersect the new state boundary line  
 22.45 ch. N. of the 181<sup>st</sup> mile tree and  
 set a post 4 ft long by 4 in dia 2 ft  
 deep in a stone mound 4 1/2 ft in dia  
 at base, 2 ft high for cor. to sec 6 & 31  
 Land steep and rocky; soil 3<sup>rd</sup> rate  
 Timber fir and yellow pine  
 Returned to the established cor. to sec.  
 6 & 31 and ran  
 West on a true line between sec. 6 & 31  
 Var. 16' 30" E

Descend along N. hill side.

15.60 To a post in a stone mound on the  
 old state boundary line  
 66.00 Top of hill, thence over a flat.  
 71.60 To a log house - a large house, 20 ft x 20 ft.  
 73.00 A stream 35 ft wide runs N. of. A house  
 about 3.00 ch. S.  
 74.00 Intersect N. boundary 3.38 ch. S. of cor.
