Timber fir and yellow pine.

Undergrowth chaparral.

August 18, 1874.

Begin at the established corner to sections 6 and 31  
and ran

East between sections 6 and 31.

Variation  $16^{\circ}30'$  east

30.90 Intersect the new state boundary line 28.77 chains  
north of the 187th mile tree and set a post 4 feet  
long by 4 inches diameter 2 feet deep in a stone mound  
 $4\frac{1}{2}$  feet diameter at base 2 feet high for corner to  
sections 6 and 31,

from which bears a

Fir 14 ins. dia. N.  $29\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W. 69 links distant.

Fir 36 ins. dia. S.  $71^{\circ}$  E. 45 links distant.

Land broken and rocky; soil third rate.

Timber fir and yellow pine.

Undergrowth chaparral.

Returned the established corner to sections 6 and 31  
and ran

West on a true line between sections 6 and 31.

Variation  $16^{\circ}30'$  east

Descend.

16.60 To the old state boundary line.

34.28 Ascend.

73.30 Intersect west boundary 152 links north of corner to  
sections 25 and 36, township 17 north range 17 east  
and set a post 4 feet long by 4 inches diameter, 2  
feet deep for closing corner to sections 6 and 31,

from which bears a

Fir 30 ins. dia. S.  $56^{\circ}$  E. 11 links distant.

Fir 24 ins. dia. N.  $47^{\circ}$  E. 26 links distant.
