Began at the established corner to sections 30 and 31
and run

S. $89^{\circ}38'E$. on line between sections 30 and 31.

Variation $16^{\circ}30'$ east

Ascend.

30.80 Intersect the new state boundary line 27.72 chains
north of the 186th mile post and set a post 4 feet
long and 4 inches diameter 2 feet deep in a stone mound
 $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet in diameter at base, 2 feet high for corner to
sections 30 and 31.

Land steep; soil third rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth chaparral.

Returned to the established corner to sections 30
and 31 and ran

West on a true line between sections 30 and 31.

Variation $16^{\circ}30'$ east

Descend.

16.50 To old state boundary line.

24.90 A brook 10 links wide runs northwest.

29.00 A brook 2 links wide runs north.

Ascend.

36.00 Descend.

49.90 A brook 5 links wide runs north.

Ascend.

73.60 Intersect west boundary 87 links north of corner to
T. 17 N. R. 17 E. and set a post
sections 24 and 25, $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet long by 4 inches diameter 2
feet deep for closing corner to sections 30 and 31

from which bears a

Fir 15 ins. dia. S. $41^{\circ}E$. 16 links distant.

Fir 24 ins. dia. N. $19\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$. 88 links distant.

Land rolling, soil third rate.

Timber yellow pine and fir.
