Subdivision begun, Oct 16. 1843

The whole of the Southern portion is an
Alkali desert, worthless. I therefore
began at the corner to Sections
18th & 19, on the West Boundary and
run thence,

East on a true line bet Sec 18th & 19
var 17° 45' East

along rolling hills.

39.68' For $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec Cor. set a granite stone 12+9+5

in ground, marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on each side, having
made allowance for the convergence
which would arise in running North
from the 8th Standard Parallel North
