General Description.

The land through Ranges 41 & 42 E and the first four miles in Range 43 East, is undulating and slopes north to the Little Humboldt River. It is covered with bunch grass and Sage Brush, and in some places with Rip Grass. All is fine grazing land. The ~~first~~ last two miles in R 43 E is high and rolling, one being lime stone hills, the other high table land.
