

Exterior Boundaries of the Reservations.

Field Notes of the Survey of the Exterior Boundaries of Camp McGivray Reservation

Began August 19, 1873

from a point 200 chains, magnetic North of the flag staff, I run thence.

$S 72^{\circ} 15' E$ along the North Boundary line of said Reservation

For $140^{\circ} 45'$ East.

At 200 chains I established a temporary corner, and finding no true corner I run.

$S 140^{\circ} 45' N$ along the East Boundary line of the Reservation.

For $140^{\circ} 45'$ East.

At 260 chains, I set a granite stone, $24 \times 18 \times 12$, marked No. 1, and made a mound of stones 3 feet high, from
