In field notes of the survey of the Fifth Standard Parallel North through Ranges 33<sup>rd</sup> & 34<sup>th</sup> East. W.D.M.

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start Begun. January 10<sup>th</sup> 1874  
at a point 6 chs 42 cks West of the closing cor. to T<sup>w</sup> 45 N Rgs 33<sup>rd</sup> & 34<sup>th</sup> E, where I set a charred three sided post 48<sup>in</sup> long sides 7<sup>in</sup> wide, 12<sup>in</sup> in ground mound 24<sup>in</sup> high, dug pits 24 x 16 x 12, post marked for Standard cor. to T<sup>w</sup> 46 N Rgs 33<sup>rd</sup> & 34<sup>th</sup> E, and run thence along said standard.

Meet on South Boundary of Sec 36  
Var 18<sup>th</sup> East,  
along valley.

32.58 Dry Channel. 8 cks wide runs S<sup>th</sup>

40.00 For 1/4 Sec cor. set a charred post 48<sup>in</sup>
